



**6. RESOLVE:** *To avoid passing retrofit costs on to renters by passing a regulation outlawing earthquakes retroactively to April 10, 1978.*




***5. RESOLVE: To discontinue considering the closing of a nearby Starbucks as the loss of a base amenity entitling a tenant to a rent decrease.***








